

Here we see a sick woman looking with a trusting smile at *La Curandera*. Her son is playing at the foot of the bed. The Curandera reassuringly leans on the bed, swiping a handful of herbs over the women's body. Curanderas are traditional native healers/shamans found in Latin America and the United States. They administer shamanistic and spiritistic remedies for mental, emotional, physical, and "spiritual" illnesses.



Perhaps it is not hard to see why artists often show empathy for what society calls illness: all creativity is an irrational voyage. The idea of going outside yourself to see things afresh is probably as old as the torchlit visions of cave artists and was expressed by the ancient Greek philosopher Plato when he wrote that poetic ecstasy is the only source of divine truth. “Madness is a gift from the gods”, as Plato put it.

Edvard Munch, *Self-portrait with the Spanish Flu*, 1919



INTRA-VENUS is Hannah Wilke's last work. She died on January 28, 1993 of complications from Lymphoma. During the later stages of her illness, she collaborated with her husband, Donald Goddard, on a series of photographs documenting the realities of her physical and mental transformation. Thirteen of these 72" x 48" images are included in the exhibition, as well as related watercolors, sculptural objects, and drawings.




