The New Colossus

By Emma Lazarus, 1883

Emma Lazarus (1849 - 1887) American poet born in New York City of Portuguese Jewish parents. Lazarus wrote 'The New Colossus' in 1883 for the occasion of an auction to raise money for the pedestal of the Statue of Liberty. The statue and her poem were placed at the harbor of Manhattan in 1903. Sadly, 'The poet of the huddled masses' died of cancer, when she was only 38 years old.

Pre-reading

- 1. 'The New Colossus' was engraved on a bronze plaque at the Statue of Liberty. The poem is a *sonnet*: a classical poetic form which has 14 *lines*, subdivided through its rhymes into two parts: I = 8 lines, an *octave*, rhyming *abbaabba*, and II = 6 lines, a *sestet*, rhyming *cdcdcd* (or *cdecde*). This is the *Petrarchan* or *Italian* sonnet; Shakespeare created his own version which has slightly different rhymes. The *meter* is an *iambic pentameter* (*da-DUM da-DUM da-DUM da-DUM da-DUM)*.
