5 Today we <u>honour</u> the <u>Indigenous</u> peoples of this land, the oldest continuing cultures in human history.

We reflect on their past mistreatment3.

We reflect in particular on the mistreatment of those who were Stolen Generations - this <u>blemished</u>⁴ chapter in our nation's history.

The time has now come for the nation to turn a new page in Australia's history by righting the wrongs of the past and so moving forward with <u>confidence</u>⁵ to the future.

We apologise for the laws and policies of <u>successive</u>⁶ Parliaments and governments that have inflicted <u>profound</u>⁷ grief, suffering and loss on these our fellow Australians.

We apologise especially for the <u>removal</u>⁸ of Aboriginal and <u>Torres Strait</u>

<u>Islander</u>⁹ children from their families, their communities and their country.

For the pain, suffering and hurt of these Stolen Generations, their <u>descendants</u>¹⁰ and for their families left behind, we say sorry.

To the mothers and the fathers, the brothers and the sisters, for the breaking up of families and communities, we say sorry.
